[CAR] IMPORTANT RESACAR UPDATE

SYNOPSIS

The direct connection agreement with Resacar for car hire has been terminated by the vendor. As a result, the final day of this connection in Neo will be 30 June 2024.

Users will be able to use GDS for their car hire requirements.

A configuration is required.

Please contact your Neo Service Manager or Account Manager for further information.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN WITH EXISTING BOOKINGS?

Following the migration from Resacar to GDS:

- **Before 30 June 2024:** Once activation has been made for the bookings on GDS, the bookings made via Resacar will only be accessible for consultation and cancelation. Any other action in the form or modification should be performed offline by the travel agency.
- **After 30 June 2024:** No action or synchronization will be possible via Resacar. Any action for existing bookings will have to be managed offline by the travel agency.

[RAIL] SILVERRAIL: UPCOMING CHANGES FOR THE SWEDISH MARKET

SYNOPSIS

Starting from **April 2024** and for a duration of several months, users of the Swedish rail market will experience some changes which affect the shopping search results and missing features.

The reason for these changes is that the carrier SJ has modified their booking system to have a better control of their inventory and products.

Silverrail is working closely with SJ and Samtrafiken to achieve a smooth transition towards these technical changes.

TECHNICAL DETAILS

- **From 3 April 2024 to 27 April 2024:** The latest bookable travel date will be **3 June 2024**
- **From 27 April:** users will be able to make bookings beyond **3 June 2024**

The following will be made visible for users from 3 June 2024:

- **Missing Features**
 - Seat map
 - Meals
 - Seat reservation
- **Carrier Contents**
 - **VyTåg** content will be available for booking starting from **11 June 2024**
 - **MRTX (ResPlus)** will be available for booking from **11 June 2024**
 - **Snalltaget** will be missing.

[PNR IMPORT] DECOMMISSIONING OF OLD PNR IMPORT ROBOT IN NEO 24.3

SYNOPSIS

The old PNR import robot will be decommissioned with the **Neo 24.3** release.

If the migration towards the new robot, which was delivered in Neo 22.4, has not yet been completed, you are encouraged to get in touch with your contact at Neo to ensure a proper configuration of Neo Admin Suite.

SYNOPSIS

For travel to or from the United Kingdom, travelers with Eurostar trains must complete the Advance Passenger Information (API) form prior to travel. Completion of the API will provide travelers with their boarding pass which is obligatory for travel. Please note that this change does not affect air travel.

The Eurostar API involves both the collection and transmission of personal data which includes travel type document (passport or ID card), travel document number, issuing country and expiry date, first name, last name, gender, nationality, and date of birth.

From 27 March 2024 and for travel from 1 April 2024, PDF ticket will no longer be available in Neo.

SNCF will replace the ticket by a trip summary.

IMPORTANT: this is NOT a ticket and cannot be used to board the train.

WHAT IS NEW IN THE BOOKING EXPERIENCE?

When a booking is made and once the ticket is issued, Neo will display the trip summary provided by the SNCF from the Travel Documents section (see screenshot below). This contains the process to complete the API and obtain the boarding pass.

Travelers must then go to **Manage Booking**. The Eurostar booking reference is the Neo Confirmation Number available directly on the user interface (see screenshot above) or on the trip summary.

Travelers should then add your name, click on **View Booking**, then **Information Required** where travelers can then complete the API.

It will then be possible for travelers to obtain their boarding pass by downloading or to email it by clicking on **Get your Ticket**.

In Neo 24.1 SP2, the activation for TER Fluo was noted for **7 March 2024**.

This date has since been modified after the publication of Neo 24.1 SP2, and TER Fluo will be now activated from **9 April 2024**.

SYNOPSIS

GrandEst has decided to move towards two main routes (Paris / Strasbourg and Paris / Troyes) from the Etoil inventory to RYO S3. (A similar change was done for the Normandy region in October 2021).

The TER Fluo will be activated by SNCF on **9 April 2024** (for travel dates starting on 6 July 2024).

NOTE: RYO signifies “Réserver, Yields, Offre” and concerns French regional trains (TER).

[HRS] REVERSE NOTIFICATION

SYNOPSIS

Changes have been made to send the GDS PNR reference to HRS. This is performed by enabling the reverse notification.

This means that once the booking is made on HRS and the passive segment is added to the GDS PNR, a new request is sent to HRS to link the GDS PNR number with the HRS reservation.

If this step is not performed, the HRS reservation would be cancelled after a certain period.

SYNOPSIS

Customers for which users only connect to Neo through a Single Sign on or mobile application may want to have better control over the security of their authentication into Neo by removing the option for users to log in directly from the Neo login page using their Neo specific username and password.

On the **Company Setup | Account Security** node in Neo Admin Suite, a new option has been added. As a result, security administrators can now restrict allowed connection methods to Neo for a given company to SSO or mobile connections only.

This prevents users from logging in with their Neo credentials on the Neo login page:


